

# 2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON HEATHER HILL ESTATE WALLA WALLA VALLEY

# TASTING NOTES

Generous aromas of figs, violets and vanilla open on the nose with hints of leather. An elegant, nicely weighted palate with fine tannins weaves together black plum and pomegranate with herbs, coffee and cured meats, developing throughout a long, satisfying finish.

## VINTAGE OVERVIEW

Cool spring weather resulted in a slow start to the 2019 growing season, but summer temperatures warmed nicely. Heat conditions were even throughout July and August, with no significant spikes. Fall temperatures were a little cooler than usual giving grapes the added benefit of extended hangtime to reach full physiological maturity and develop excellent natural acidity resulting in wines notable for generous aromatics and finesse.
